When Town Cats rescues unsocialized or feral cats from an unsafe situation, we have to consider non-traditional adoption placement. These cats are healthy, sterilized, vaccinated, and in need of a new rural outdoor home, such as a barn, stable, garage, warehouse or vineyard. When you bring the new cats home, they will need to be confined to an escape-proof room or enclosure like a tack room, garage, coop, or XXL dog crate for 3-4 weeks while they acclimate to their new surroundings. You will feed/water and clean the litter pan daily during the confinement period. After this period of confinement, the cats will usually accept their new home and may be released. You will continue to provide daily food and water and allow them access to shelter such as your barn or garage. Low Cost Spay/Neuter Options are available.

Have you been feeding the neighborhood cats only to find that there seem to be more and more of them depending on you for their next meal?

We can help!

Town Cats has partnered with two spay neuter clinics that offer us a reduced price of \$45 for the spay or neuter, rabies shot, distemper shot and flea treatment. If other medical issues are discovered there will be an additional fee to cover those costs. Volunteers transport the felines to the clinic several times a month. The transport meeting location for drop off is at 7:20 AM in the Walgreens parking lot in Ocean Pines off of Cathell Road. Returning cats can be expected later that evening around 7PM.

Scheduling is by appointment only. Please be patient as we are limited to the number of cats we are able to send to clinic.

We are always looking for volunteers to help transport needy cats to clinics on Tuesday and/or Thursday mornings. Just 2 hours of your time saves lives!!

All are displayed on a creamy background framed in Lilac. Surrounding this lovely scene is a frame of hearts and puffy flowers in shades of blue, light blue, and purple on a cream background enhanced by traditional quilting squares in each corner. Martha also used dark blue framing and more traditional quilting block patterns to border the edges. Martha has decided to "retire" from her work with us to spend more time with her family.
